

MDS Clinical Comparison Report

This report shows MDS values of the resident's various MDS assessments. For each MDS item, it shows what value was entered in each MDS, over a period of time.

Report Display

Top Line:

Changes Only. Report shows only those MDS items that changed over time. An item that consistently has the same value is not shown. If you uncheck this option and click **Refresh**, the report shows every item in the MDS. This way you can see the values even if they haven't changed. However, an item where no value was ever entered, will not display.

From / To dates. The report initially shows assessments of the last 180 days (about 6 months). Both the "From" date and the "To" date can be changed. Clicking **Refresh** will show the assessments within the new range.

If there are no assessments within the date range, a message displays with this message. Similarly, if there is only one assessment in that range of dates, "comparison" is then impossible, and a message explains that there is only one MDS between these dates.

Report Headings:

The column headings identify the assessment. The first line shows the year, the second line shows the month and day, and the third line shows the type of MDS, known as the ISC (the "Item Subset Code" that appears on an MDS Submission Validation Report). They are:

NC	Comprehensive (such as Admission, Significant Change, Annual).
ND	Discharge
NO	OMRA: Start of Therapy or Start & End Therapy
NOD	OMRA and Discharge
NP	PPS (MPAF)
NQ	Quarterly
NS	OMRA – Start of Therapy
NSD	OMRA – Start of Therapy and Discharge

NT forms are Tracking Records, and they are ignored.

The fourth line shows the RUGS score for that assessment.

Body of Report:

All clinical MDS items, from Section B through Section V, are shown, except:

Section S	Items specific to individual states
V0100 A-F	Items from the most recent OBRA or PPS
V0200 B-C	CAA and Care Plan signature dates

For clinical purposes, "**Skip**" (^) and "**Not-Assessed**" (-) are treated and displayed as blanks. A diamond occurs for items that don't appear for that form, and is not counted as a "change".

To see all the items, scroll down.

The last column shows that meaning of the code values entered into the MDS. To see the entire message, or if the number of assessments exceeds the width of the screen, scroll to the right.

End of Report:


Beneath the last line of the report, you will find a total of how many lines (items) were shown. This may be useful for quickly comparing the results of different reports.

Click on the **Reports** tab. Clinical Comparison is the fourth report shown.




From inside the MDS:
